

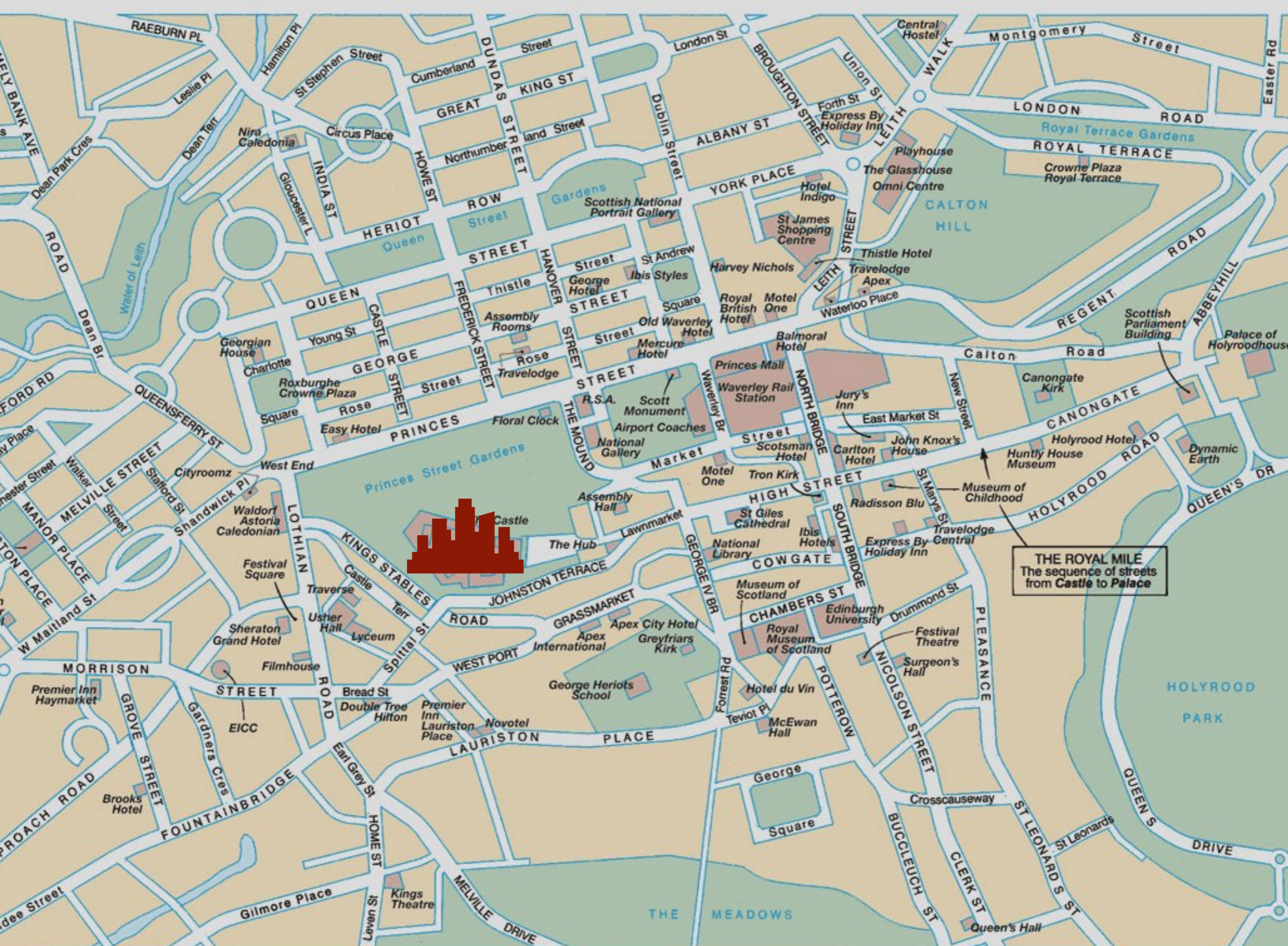

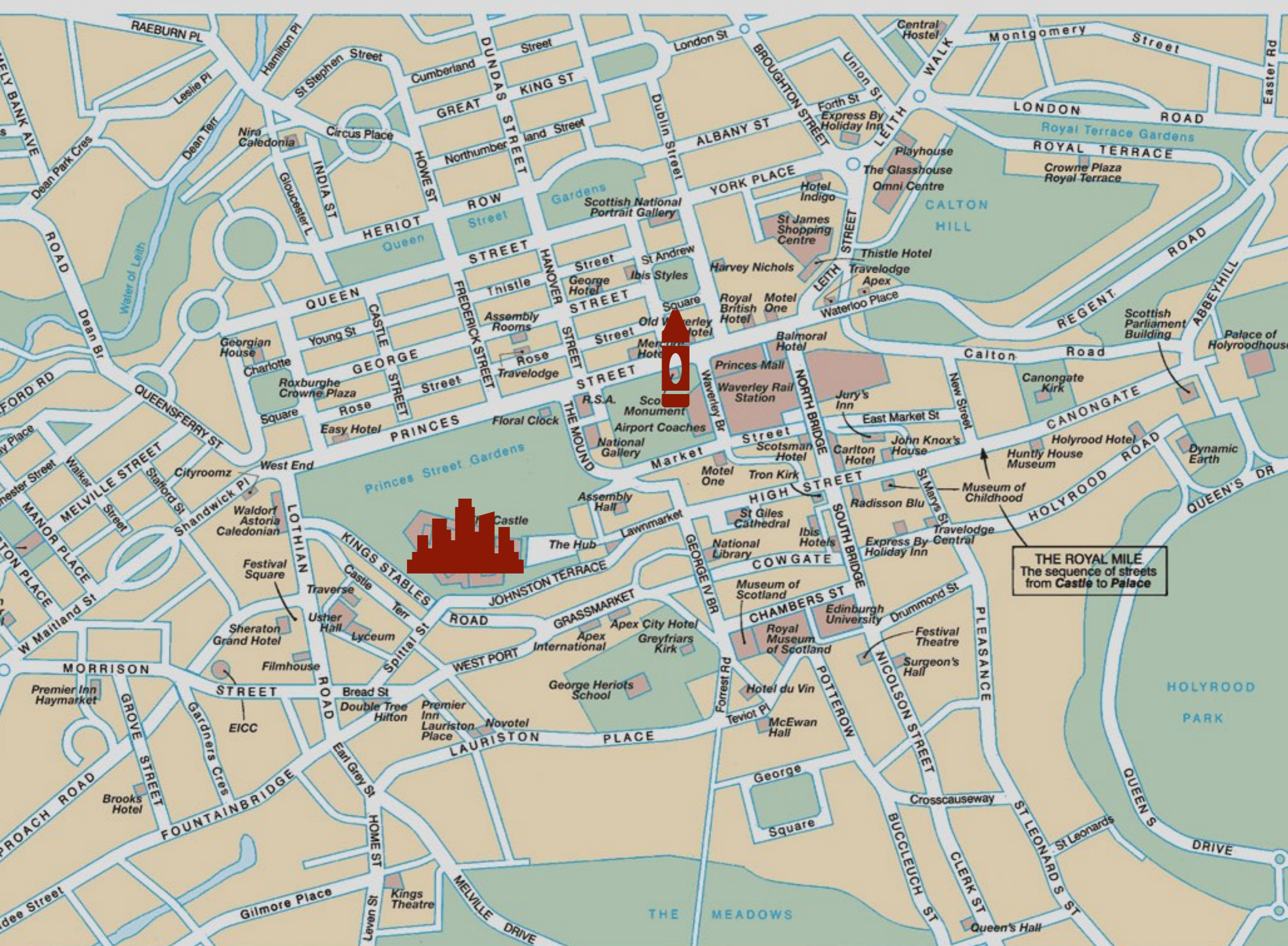

64 sculptures

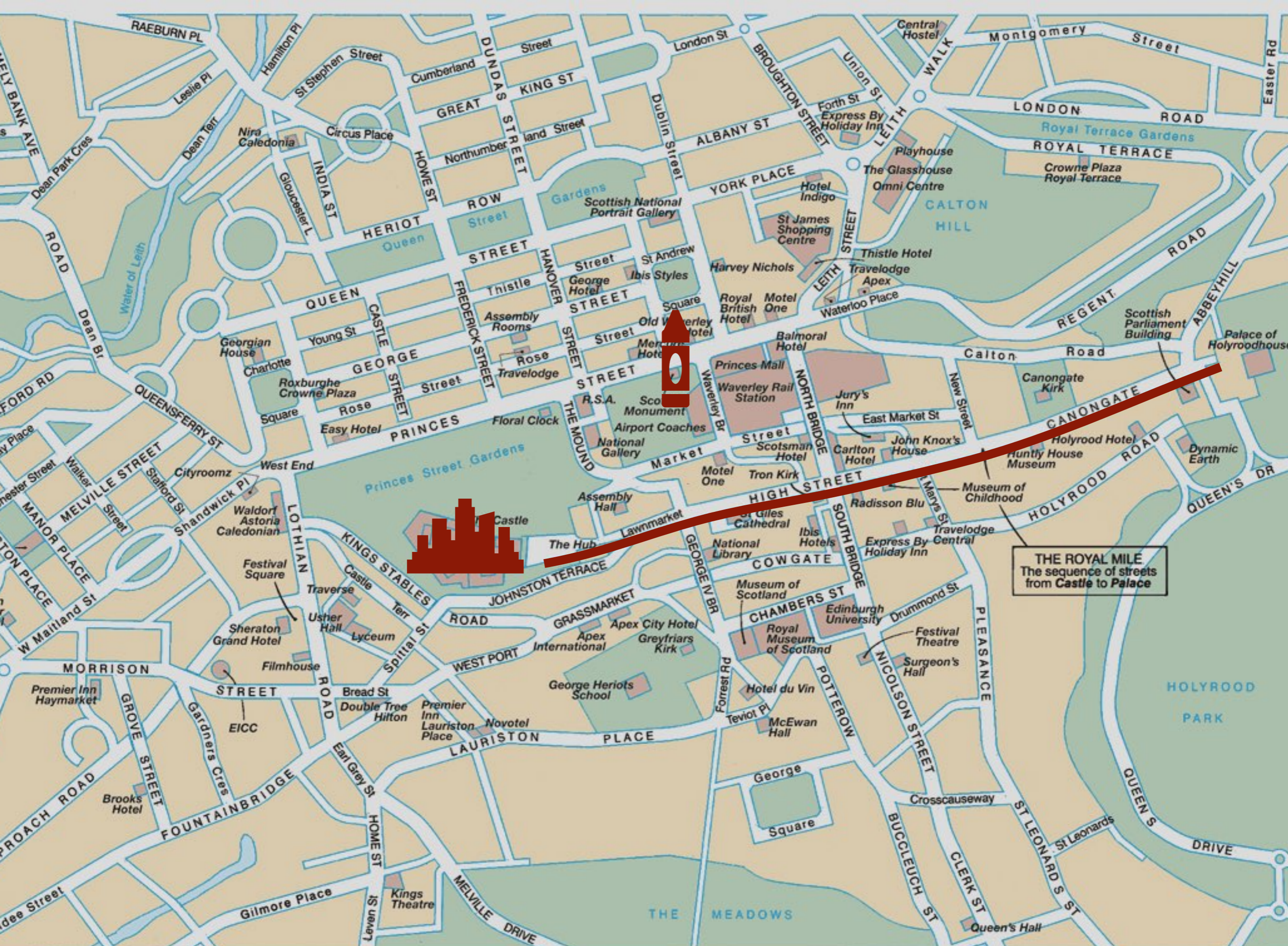


SIR WALTER SCOTT

Scottish literature

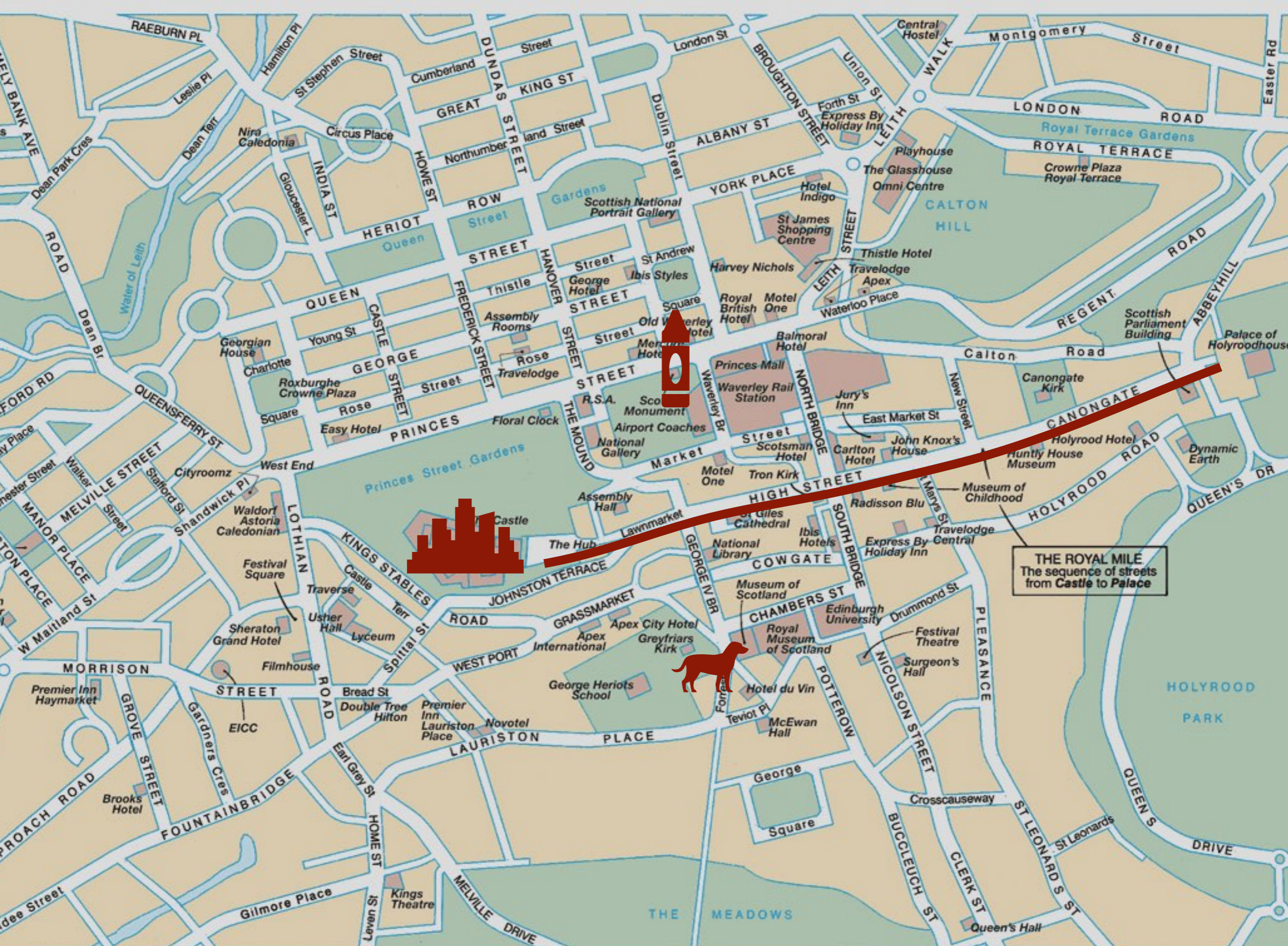


THE ROYAL MILE

the streets which make up the Royal Mile are (W to E) Castlehill, the Lawnmarket, the High Street, the Canongate and Abbey Strand

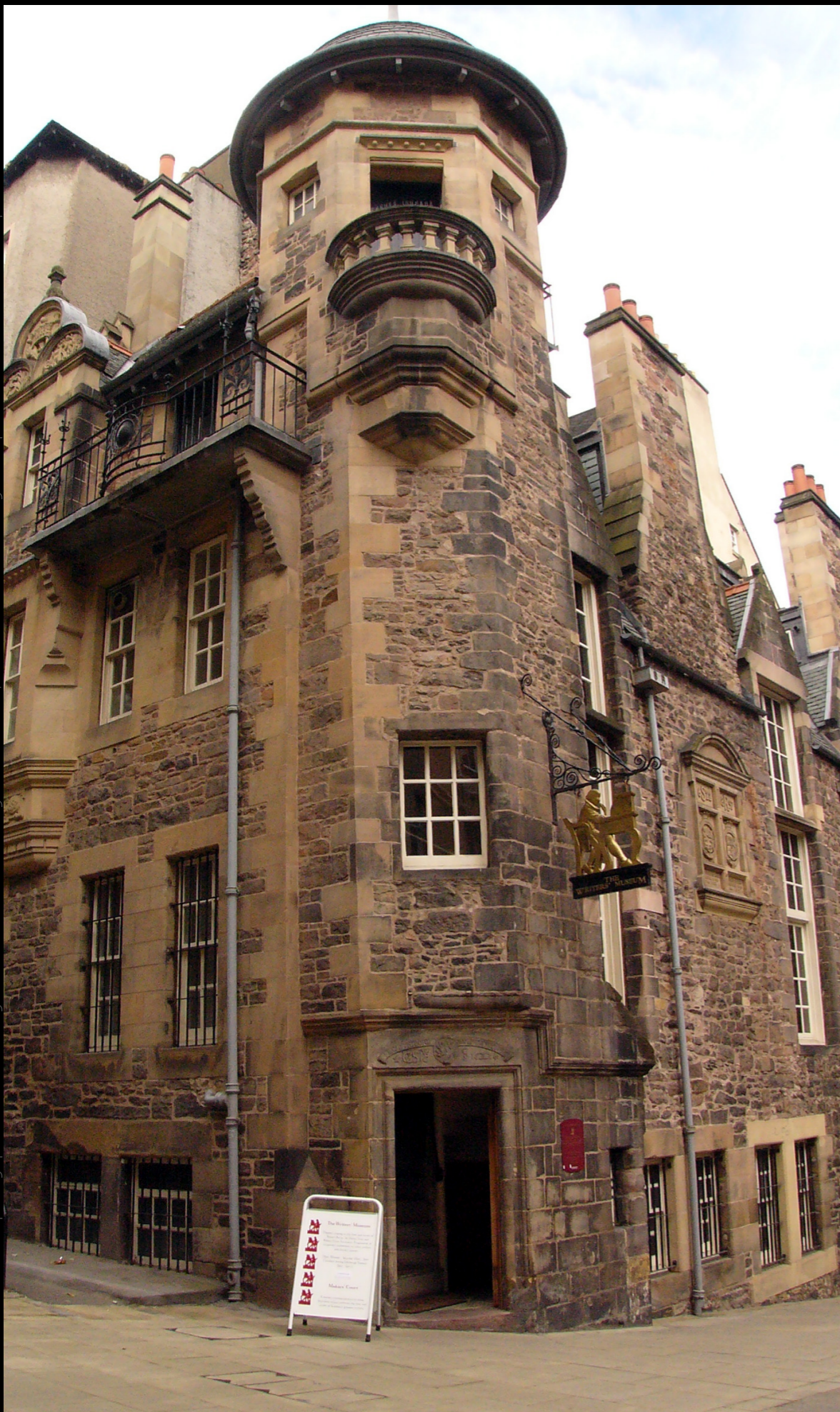

Jan. 25 1759 - Jul. 21 1796

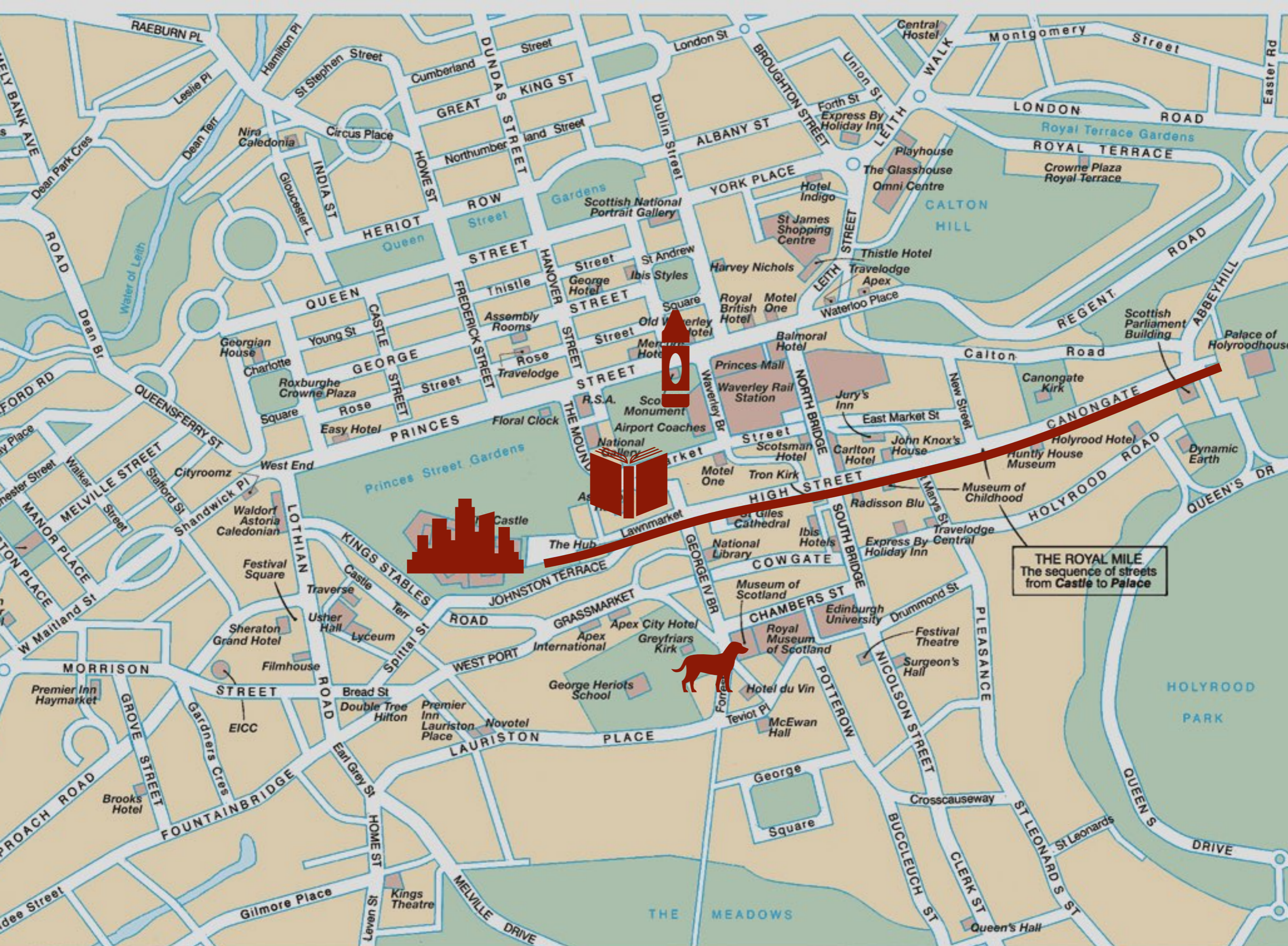
Scottish poet and lyricist
